You may be interested in seeing four of the St. Martinville homes of Oscar and Felecie Durand's children as well as St. Michael's Cemetery where you can view the Durand Triad Memorial and one of the Durand Family tombs. The descriptions numbered from (1) to (6) below will correspond to the locations numbered from (1) to (6) on the map of St. Martinville.

In addition, you will find number (7) directing you to Pine Alley where, almost two hundred years ago, Gerome Charles Durand (father of Oscar Jerome Durand) planted an alley of oak and pine trees extending several miles from his plantation home to the Bayou Teche.

- (1) 421 S. Main Street, home of Blanche Durand Bonin
- (2) 415 S. Main Street, home of Felecie Durand Simoneaux
- (3) 304 Washington Street, home of Albert and Louisiana Durand
- (4) 223 Gary Street is said to be an exact replica of the original Gerome Charles Durand home built at Pine Alley.
- (5) 415 E. Bridge Street, home of Stella Durand Resweber
